If all rear seats are occupied by children less than 4 years of age, then child may be positioned in a child restraint system in the front seat. "A child in a rear-facing child restraint system may be placed in the front seat only if the front passenger airbag is deactivated." 	MCL 257,710d

Exceptions:

"If there are more passengers than safety belts available for use, and all safety belts are being utilized in compliance with (MCL 257.710e) the operator of the motor vehicle is in compliance with (MCL 257.710e)."

"...the operator of a motor vehicle transporting a child 8 years of age or older but less than 16 years of age for which there is not an available safety belt is in compliance with (MCL 257.710e(5)) if that child is seated in other than the front seat of the motor vehicle."

Penalty:

Fines, civil infraction, no points.
