A security vessel dedication & dock system ribbon cutting ceremony have been established to celebrate the completion of a collaborative multi-agency grant project.

The City of New Baltimore initiated partnerships by teaming up with the Macomb County Sheriff's Office, Detroit-Wayne Port Authority, & Department of Homeland Security/FEMA to provide the citizens & visitors of the Bay Area with the tools & infrastructure to accommodate a *Comprehensive Regional Maritime Public Security, Safety and Response Program* that facilitates connections to agencies represented by each level of our government.

Funding for the regional security program and infrastructure was provided by the **FY 2008 Port Security Grant Program.** The **Walter & Mary Burke Estate** is credited for allocating the additional funding to provide day-slip docking for the public's use while visiting our region.
