# Community Share-Cam

Community Share-Cam is a community safety program recently instituted by the New Baltimore Police Department (NBPD) which allows both residents and businesses to partner with officers in the fight against crime in our neighborhoods. Simply by registering your home or business Surveillance System with the New Baltimore Police Department you can be an invaluable asset in solving crimes in your area. When a crime occurs in your neighborhood, the New Baltimore Police will make contact with you and request a copy of your video footage. This footage can help establish leads, identify suspects and save valuable investigative time. All registered camera locations will be confidential and stored in a secure database in our Records Management System, which in turn will allow officers to map out locations of cameras throughout the city. Community Share-Cam <u>does not</u> provide the New Baltimore Police with direct access to your Surveillance Systems. Residents and Businesses will only be contacted by officers in the event of a crime occurring in the area of their camera coverage.

### **How It Works**

#### 1) Registration

Registration is easy and takes just a few minutes to complete three simple steps. You provide basic contact information and tell us where your cameras are located. There is <u>NO Cost</u> to register.

#### 2) Confirmation

Once you completed the registration process, a member of the New Baltimore Police will follow up with you to confirm your registration information.

#### 3) Call for Assistance

The New Baltimore Police will only contact you if there is a criminal or suspicious incident in your area that video footage may be of use to solve or assist the investigation. When contacted, the Investigations Bureau may request a copy of any video captured by your cameras.

- 1) Any video footage collected by the New Baltimore Police Department relating to criminal activity may be used in the investigation and as evidence during any stage of the criminal proceeding.
- 2) Video footage provided to the New Baltimore Police Department is reserved for official use only.
- 3) Under no circumstances shall registrants construe that they are acting as an agent/ or employee of the New Baltimore Police Department through the Community Share-Cam Program.
- 4) When necessary the New Baltimore Police Department will contact you directly using the information you have provided to obtain surveillance video footage.
- 5) You agree not to release any video footage or still images to the media without consulting with the New Baltimore Police Department.
